ITINERARY

Day 1: Travel to Kaziranga National Park

Meals: L, D

On arrival at Guwahati airport, you will be met and transferred approximately 5 hours by private car to Kaziranga National Park. Here your wildlife adventure begins.



Destination Information

Kaziranga National Park - Covering an area of approximately 430 sq kms, the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Kaziranga National Park is home to the world's largest population of the Indian One-Horned Rhinoceros as well as the Indian Wild Water Buffalo. It has also earned the distinction of having the highest density of Royal Bengal Tigers (one every five sq. km.), making this park an incredibly rich biodiversity hotspot. With its marshy swamps and thickets of elephant grass, the park supports large populations of Indian elephants, Indian bison, swamp deer, and Capped Langurs.

Day 2: Safari in the Park

Meals: B, L, D

Morning and evening safaris offer the chance to see the great Indian one-horned rhinoceros, herds of Asian elephants, wild Asiatic water buffaloes, and eastern swamp deer, among other wildlife. The park is a haven for bird watchers, watchers, but also be on the lookout for the endangered Ganges dolphin that have made its rivers their sanctuary. The day ends with stunning sunset views.

Day 3: Explore the Park

Another thrilling day with morning and afternoon safaris in the parl. Your safari's will be filled with opportunities for close encounters with some of India's most iconic wildlife. Keep a lookout for leopard cats, the rare hispid hare or a sloth bear. Kaziranga is home to nine of the sixteen primate species found in India, ensuring an enthralling experience throughout the day.



Day 4: Depart Kaziranga National Park

Meals: B
