ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive Tunxi

Meals: None

Your guide will meet you at your hotel in Shanghai and together you will transfer to the station to board the bullet train to Tunxi. The rest of the day is at leisure.

**Day 2: Yellow Mountain**

Meals: B, L

Today, ascend to the summit of Mount Huang, commonly known as Yellow Mountain, by cable car for an overnight stay atop the mountain.

Enjoy the spectacular views of the oddly shaped peaks, rock formations, thousand year-old pine trees and ever-changing mist, all of which have inspired local artists for centuries.

Spend the afternoon exploring this stunning UNESCO World Heritage Site.

**Destination Information**

Mount Huang - Mount Huang has played an important role in the history of art and literature in China since the Tang Dynasty. A legend dated from the year 747 described the mountain as a place of discovery of the elixir of immortality.

Day 3: Tunxi

Meals: B, L

Take the cable car down to the base of the mountain and explore this ancient town of Tunxi.

The narrow cobbled streets are lined with pretty little shops selling anything from local snacks and tea, to paintbrushes, cultural relics and intricate wood carvings.

Stay overnight in Tunxi.

Destination Information

Tunxi Ancient Street - Tunxi Ancient Street is well located in the centre of Tunxi District of Huangshan City. With about 630 years' history, Tunxi Ancient Street is the best preserved old street in China in the style of the Southern Song Dynasty, Ming and Qing Dynasties.

Day 4: Depart Tunxi

Meals: B, L

There are many Huizhou style ancient villages scattered at the foot of Mount Huang that boast precious cultural heritage. Begin the day with a visit to local villages and learn about local lifestyle.

Then, transfer to the station to board your bullet train to Shanghai, where arrangements end.
