ITINERARY

Day 1: Kurashiki Day Tour

Meals: None

Meet your guide at your hotel in Osaka. Together, transfer to Osaka Station by taxi to board the bullet train to Okayama and then transfer by local train to Kurashiki.

Explore the Kurashiki Museum of Folk Crafts and take a leisurely stroll in picturesque Bikan Historical Quarter.



Return to Okayama and visit Korakuen garden, before returning to your hotel.

Destination Information

Kurashiki – Kurashiki is a picturesque city that was once a prominent rice distribution center. The city's former storehouses, now converted into museums, boutiques and cafes, and well preserved canal area dates back to the Edo Period (1603-1867).

Day 2: Travel to Naoshima

Meals: B

Meet your guide at your hotel in Okayama and transfer by public transport to Uno Port for the ferry to Naoshima.

Today, visit the Art House Project, Benesse House Museum and Chichu Art Museum (closed Mondays).



Destination Information

Naoshima - A haven for contemporary art lovers, Naoshima is an island in the Seto Inland Sea that is known for its contemporary art museums, architecture and sculptures. With sandy beaches, sunny weather and a laid-back feel, this is the perfect relaxing getaway from Japan's large urban areas.

Day 3: Depart Naoshima

Meals: B

Enjoy the morning at leisure. Your guide will meet you this afternoon at your hotel in Naoshima and together you will take the ferry to Okayama. Then board the bullet train to Osaka and transfer to your hotel.
