### **ITINERARY**

# Day 1: Travel to Vung Tau

Meals: L

This morning you will be met at your Saigon hotel and transferred by private car approximately 3 hours to the coastal town of Vung Tau, southeast of Saigon. Upon arrival you will check in to your hotel.

Afterwards, commence your sightseeing around town, starting with the former Royal residence Bach Dinh, also known as 'White Villa'. Next you will visit the Reclining Buddha and explore the 8km stretch of sand, sun and tourists at Back Beach.



Please note over the next two days you will be touring on foot over uneven terrain so good walking shoes are necessary.

# **Destination Information**

**Vung Tau -** Vung Tau is a charming coastal city that offers a mix of beautiful beaches, rich history, and delicious seafood.

# Day 2: Nui Dat & Long Tan

Meals: B, L

This morning travel to Hoa Long village.

Then continue to Nui Dat where you will visit the old bunkers, Kangaroo pad, SAS hill (Nui Dat hill) and Lusbcome air field.

Later in the day, head to nearby Long Tan village to encounter the Long Tan Cross, the towering memorial that marks the site of the village's namesake battle.



The journey continues at the Horse Shoe hill, a former Fire Support Base, and the Long Phuoc Tunnels, which linked the village to the surrounding rubber plantation, and the adjacent museum.

### **Destination Information**

**Hao Long -** Hoa Long is home to the infamous battleground where the Royal Australian Regiment and the Viet Cong clashed.

**Nui Dat -** Where the Australian army base was located between 1966 to 1971. Nui Dat is the location of old army bunkers, the Kangaroo pad, SAS hill (Nui Dat hill) and Lusbcome airfield.



Day 3: Return to Saigon Meals: B

After check-out this morning, you will be transferred by private car approximately 3 hours to your Saigon hotel.
